John Mulaney broke into the business as a writer on *Saturday Night Live* for six seasons from 2008-2012—co-creating the popular character “Stefon” with *SNL* cast member Bill Hader. He has three stand-up comedy specials available on Netflix: *New in Town*, *The Comeback Kid*, and his most recent, *Kid Gorgeous at Radio City*. Mulaney won an Emmy® for Outstanding Writing for a Variety Special for *Kid Gorgeous*. In addition to his stand-up specials, Mulaney also starred in a Broadway show titled *Oh, Hello*, which he created and wrote with fellow comedian Nick Kroll.

A current cast member on *Saturday Night Live*, comedian **Pete Davidson** has also appeared on the MTV shows *Wild ‘n Out* and *Guy Code*; *Jimmy Kimmel Live*; and guest-starred in *Brooklyn Nine-Nine*. Davidson shot his first one-hour stand up special for Comedy Central in 2016 and was named one of *Forbes*’ 2016 “30 Under 30.” Most recently, he can be seen in the Netflix comedy *Set It Up* and his upcoming projects include Netflix’s Mötley Crüe biopic *The Dirt* and the independent film *Big Time Adolescence*.
